This means the magnification will equal 20 times what you see with your eyes and the 50 is the width of the length, which is what determines how much light is gathered. The more light the better the image will be visible in the dark and for astronomy, all star gazing is typically done after dark. A lot of the cheap astronomical telescopes try to sell you on fancy gadgets. They look good to have on your new beginner telescope, but the truth is that these kind of features will be of no use. Consider on a \$100 beginner telescope that comes with loads of fancy gadgets, most of the money is going on those features. All you need to get started in astronomy with a beginner telescope is to make sure more of your money goes on the astronomical telescope mirror, astronomical telescope mount, and astronomical telescope lenses.
